This Table-Top Exercise (TTX) will give you the tools to create a TTX for your Health Center: <i>A tabletop exercise is a group discussion led by a facilitator, using a narrated, clinically relevant emergency scenario, and a set of problem statements, directed messages, or prepared questions designed to challenge an emergency plan.</i>
